Convictions of adults in 2020

Convictions declined by 11% in 2020

In 2020 around 95 000 adult convictions were registered in the conviction register. This corresponds to a drop of 11% compared with the 2019 year. The greatest decline was seen for convictions under the Foreign National and Integration Act (-17%). Among the sentences imposed, a particularly marked reduction was observed in custodial sentences with a duration of more than two years (-27%). The courts ordered expulsion in 1841 convictions (-12%). These are some of the findings of the adult conviction statistics produced by the Federal Statistical Office (FSO).
