Swiss Consumer Price Index in June 2018

Consumer prices remained stable in June

Neuchâtel, 5 July 2018 (FSO) – **The consumer price index (CPI) remained stable in June 2018 compared with the previous month, reaching 102.1 points (December 2015=100). Inflation was 1.1% compared with the same month of the previous year. These are the results of the Federal Statistical Office (FSO).**

The stability of the index compared with the previous month is the result of opposing trends that counterbalanced each other overall. Prices for international package holidays, fruiting vegetables and fuel recorded an increase. In contrast, prices for clothing, footwear and air transport decreased.

Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP)

In June 2018, the Swiss Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP) stood at 101.11 points (base 2015=100). This corresponds to a rate of change of 0.0% compared with the previous month and of +0.9% compared with the same month the previous year.

The HICP is a supplementary indicator for inflation based on a harmonised method across EU member countries. It enables inflation in Switzerland to be compared with that of European countries.

The results are published by the European Statistical Office, Eurostat, according to a predefined calendar. The FSO publishes a comparison between inflation in Switzerland and Europe on the webpage www.ipch.bfs.admin.ch. A methodological notice, the 2018 weighting of the Swiss standard HICP basket and the FSO News publication on the HICP are also available on this page. The HICP indices for other European countries for June 2018 will be published by Eurostat on 18 July 2018. 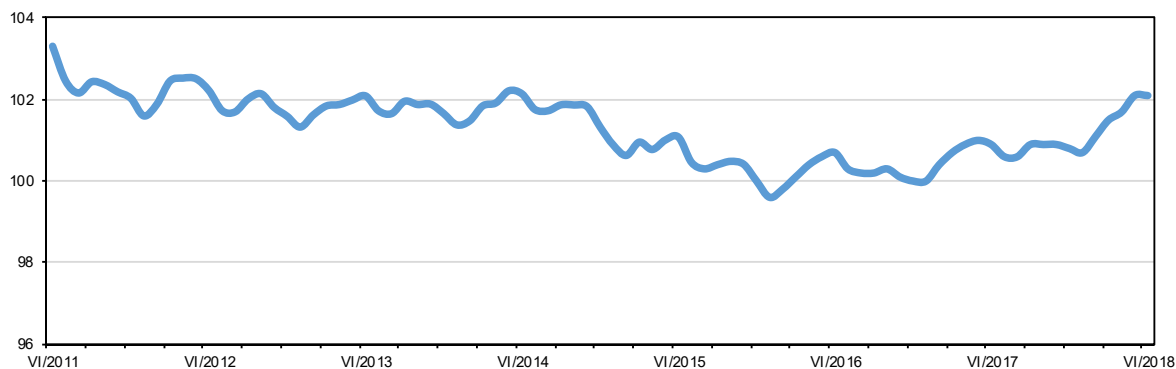

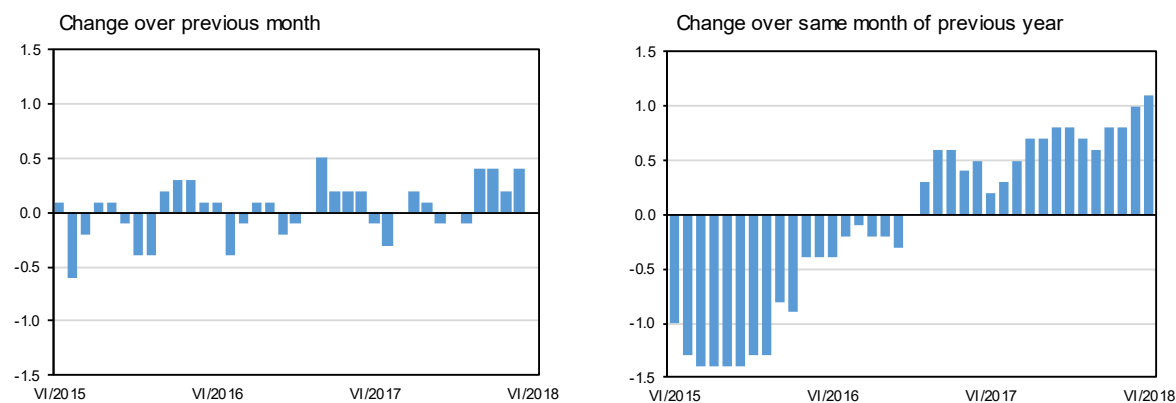

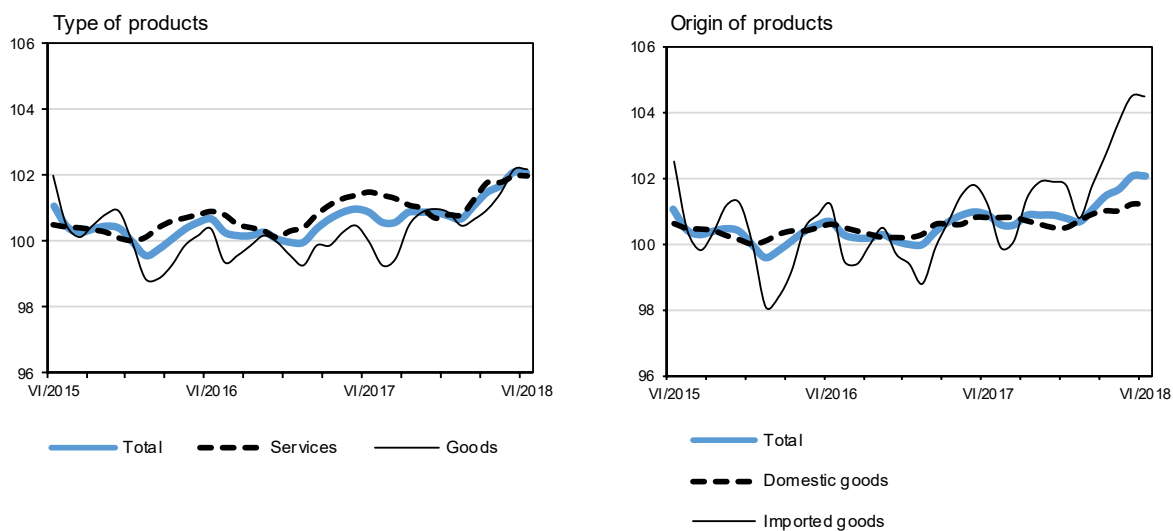
G1 Swiss Consumer Price Index (December 2015 = 100): index evolution
